The Oak Lodge Motor Inn served as low-income housing for dozens of Waco residents. The property was sold in Spring of 2021 to be demolished for retail spacing. Longtime residents were suddenly left to find new housing. We are happy to share Mr. Brian Colwick, an Oak Lodge Motor Inn resident featured in the Waco Tribune-Herald, was able to get assistance through our Veterans Case Management Program. Working with our Veterans Case Manager, Caritas was able to help Brian with locating temporary and long-term housing. In addition, Caritas was able to provide financial assistance to cover his first month's rent and utilities, after relocation. While finding his new home, Caritas also provided Brian with transportation assistance.
