Tony is a single dad caring for his five children, ages 13, 10, 8, 7, and 6. He was granted full custody in 2017.

"I first came to Caritas because I needed help with food to feed the children," said Tony. "I did not seek help until I truly needed it and Caritas was there to help my family."

In order to work full-time, Tony's mother was able to step in and help with the children, but it was not a longterm solution.

"I needed to find work with a flexible schedule, so I could be there for my kids," he said. "Caritas was able to provide the funding I needed to enroll in barber school. It was a perfect fit for me, so Ican make a stable living and manage my own hours."

Tony said he is grateful for the support he received and wants to give back one day.

"What better gift can I give my kids than to show them I went back to school. To show them that if I can do it, they can do it. To keep trying. My goal is to turn around and give back, to help others like I was. That is what I want to do."

In three weeks, Tony will complete the barber school program and receive <u>his certification</u>.

"I am so appreciative to be able to spend more time with my kids, to have more family time," he said. "I am just so grateful for what Caritas has done, I am almost speechless."
